## PICTURE BASED WORK TRACKER

This clever design is perfect for younger kids. It allows them to track their progress in a fun and accessible way while making it easy on parents to see what's been done. It uses a combination of words and pictures to help kids track what they have completed and see how much they have left.

# HOW TO USE

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR TRACKER

- Step 1: Select which sheets will be most useful to you. We've included a sheet with pictures and subjects along with a sheet that has blank spot for you to write in the subject or task of your choice (e.g. art, piano, play outside, etc). Allow your child to color in the picture.
- Step 2: Select the blank square sheet labeled "Done" that you like the most. We've included one with colors and one without.
- Step 3: Cut out the subject rectangles with pictures.
- Step 4: Separately, laminate the pictures and a sheet with blank squares. Cut out the laminated subjects.
- Step 5: Select a reusable way to adhere the pictures to the squares (e.g. velcro, glue dots, etc)
- Step 6: Have you child move a picture to the done rectangles when they've completed a subject for the day.



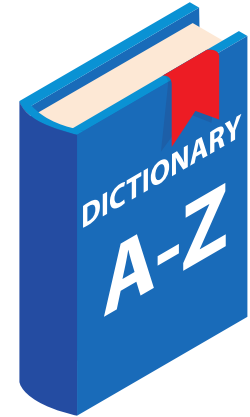
