## HOW TO USE THIS DAILYSCHEDULE

We designed this Daily Schedule with the homeschooler in mind. The homeschool schedule is usually more dynamic than the schedule of kids in conventional school. That's because homeschoolers kids are actively involved in their community in various ways at different times on different days.
We have created this schedule to be flexible to fit your unique family's needs. The Daily Schedule is a useful tool for designing your regular schedule - meaning those activities that repeat every week. It works best as a planning and reference tool. A shared digital calendar works best for ever-changing activities like playdates and appointments.

You'll find six pages of schedules that look similar but have one important difference. Each page has a different number of columns. The number of columns corresponds with the number of people you are creating a schedule for. If you have a family of 5 (including the parents), you'll want to print the sheet with a 5 in the upper right-hand corner. You may also find it helpful to use our weekly planner, which will give you a quick overview of the week.

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Select the page with the number of people in your family (including parents).

Write the names of each family member in the names row at the top and check which day of the week you're working on.

Fill in the schedule for each family member.

Large Families: If you have more than seven people in your family, you'll want to print more than one sheet. For example, if you have eight people in your family, consider printing 2 of the four people sheets. That will give you eight columns one for each family member.

Driving Time: Include driving time and any prep time needed. These time consumers are often invisible in our schedule, but homeschoolers can spend a fair amount of time in the car. Accounting for that will give you a more accurate view of your schedule.

Color: Color in the hours each person is involved in their activity.

Laminate: Consider laminating each sheet before writing on it. That will allow you to use it repeatedly and make changes as needed.


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
